## THE PURPOSE OF THE BOOK

---

- The book of Daniel, more than any other book, gives the prophetic overview of the times of the gentiles, under the reign of the all-powerful Nebuchadnezzar.
  - Darby: *the "dominion of the head of the Gentiles, and of the Gentile kings"* <sup>1</sup>
  - Scofield: *"But Daniel is distinctively the prophet of the "times of the Gentiles" (Lk. 21:24, refs.). His vision sweeps the whole course of Gentile world-rule to its end in catastrophe, and to the setting up of the Messianic kingdom."* <sup>2</sup>
- The book is about the reign of the Gentile kings, but is concerned with the condition of the Jewish remnant.
